



STANDARD PENALTIES

In accordance with Sailing Instruction 16.10, the Race Committee may apply the following standard penalties when the following regulations are infringed:

S.I. 4.4 - A boat shall not leave the shore until flag D is displayed ashore.	One point scoring penalty in her first race of the day.
S.I. 11.3 – Boats whose warning signal has not been made shall stay at least 50m to leeward of starting line.	One point scoring penalty in the race nearest in time to the incident.
S.I. 15.1.1 – First Penalty signalled after boat has crossed finish line.	10% point scoring penalty without hearing but not more than DSQ.
S.I. 15.2.2 – Boat sailed without centreboard stopper or mast retention line	20 point scoring penalty without hearing in the last completed race in which she was sailing without centreboard stopper or mast retention line.
S.I. 15.2.3 – Sail, Top Mast or Bottom Mast changed prior to a race without permission.	DSQ without hearing from the last completed race when the changed equipment was used.
S.I. 15.2 – Failure to keep well clear of race area after finishing	One point scoring penalty the nearest race of the day.
