

# S&D YACHTS FOUNDATION DAY REGATTA

16<sup>th</sup>/17<sup>th</sup> March 2024

## NOTICE OF RACE

### 1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024.
- 1.2 No national authority prescriptions will apply.
- 1.3 The following Class Rules will apply:
  - The International Optimist Dinghy Association
  - The International Laser Class Association.
  - IQFOIL Class Association
  - The International SB20 Class Association.
- 1.4 English is the official language for the event, notwithstanding that Notices may be issued in another language. The English text will take precedence.
- 1.5 This is a Class Ranking event of the Malta Sailing Federation.

### 2. ADVERTISING

- 2.1. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

### 3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to Sailors in the following classes; -

#### OPTIMIST CLASS

**Senior Division** – Boys & Girls born between 2012 and 2009 (12 – 14yrs)

**Cadet Division** – Boys & Girls born between 2016 and 2013 (8 - 11yrs)

These Divisions shall sail together and Cadet results shall be extrapolated from the whole class.

**Novices Division** - Boys and Girls born between 2016 and 2009, (8 – 14yrs) and have been sailing for not more than 12 months.

#### ILCA CLASSES

- (1) **ILCA 4** – No Age restrictions shall apply.
- (2) **ILCA 6**,
- (3) **ILCA 7**.

3.2 Four or more boats shall constitute a class.

3.3 Eligible sailors may enter by completing the electronic entry form found on the MYSC Website – <https://www.maltayoungsailors.com/registration/>. No applications without payment shall be accepted.

3.4 No further entries will be accepted after the 13<sup>th</sup> March 2024.

3.5 Entries are accepted on a first come first served basis, late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organizers including a late entry penalty stipulated below.

#### 4. CLASSIFICATION

4.1. The ISAF Sailor Classification Code will apply.

#### 5. FEES

5.1. Entry Fee shall be:

- €30 – Optimist/Laser Classes/Foiling/LT (Late Payment Fee €45)
- €60 – SB20 Classes (Late Payment Fee €75)

6.1. The number of races on each day may vary depending on the weather conditions and may be reduced or cancelled altogether. This shall remain at the discretion of the Principal Race Officer.

6.2. The Principal Race Officer in conjunction with the Organizing Authority shall notify all competitors the time of the First Warning Signal on Sunday 16/03/2024 by means of a notice on the Official Notice Board.

## **7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

7.1. The sailing instructions will be available, as from Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> March from the Malta Young Sailors Club website, <https://www.maltayoungsailors.com/foundationday/> and/or sent via email to all coaches and club representatives.

## **8. VENUE**

8.1 The Regatta shall take place on the waters in and outside St. Paul's Bay on the northeast shore of Malta.

## **9. THE COURSES**

9.1 Course diagrams shall be available in the Sailing Instructions.

9.2 The Course for the SB20 and IQFoil class shall be separate and distinct from the Optimist and ILCA Course.

## **10. SCORING**

10.1 The Low Point Scoring system shall be used.

10.2 In each class three (3) races are required to be completed to constitute the regatta.

10.3 When fewer than 4 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

10.4 When 4 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

## **11. SUPPORT BOATS**

11.1 Support boats shall be marked to be easily identified.

11.2 Coach and/or Support Boat are strictly prohibited from using the Club Slipway on Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> March. Coach/Support Boats may be launched on Friday 15<sup>th</sup> March between 10:00 and 17:00.

## 12. STORAGE OF BOATS

12.1 Boats shall be kept in their assigned places in the designated boat park as indicated by the Organising Authority.

12.2 The designated boat park shall be open and available to receive boats on Friday 15<sup>th</sup> March between 5pm – 7:30pm. It is advised that boats are congregated together according to respective clubs.

12.3 **For SB20:** Boats may be kept on moorings in the areas adjacent to Malta Young Sailors Club between Friday 21<sup>st</sup> March and Sunday 23<sup>rd</sup> March, weather permitting and at the sole discretion of the Boat Owners.

## 13. PRIZES

13.1 Class Prizes will be given as follows:

- Optimist Class:
  - i. First, Second and Third position in Senior, Cadet divisions and Novice category.
  - ii. First, Second and Third female Senior, Cadet divisions and Novice category of six (6) registered female Optimist sailors and over.
  - iii. **OR** First female in Senior, Cadet divisions and Novice if less than six (6) registered female Senior, Cadet divisions and Novice shall be taking part.
  - iv. The Foundation Day Regatta Trophy will be awarded to the First Optimist Overall.
- ILCA Classes:
  - i. First, Second and Third positions in any ILCA constituted Classes.
  - ii. First, Second and Third female ILCA sailors in any ILCA class of six (6) registered female ILCA sailors and over.
  - iii. **OR** First female in any ILCA class if less than six (6) registered female ILCA sailors shall be taking part.
- SB20 Class:
  - i. First, Second and Third positions in class (if more than 4 participants are duly registered).
- IQFoil
  - i. First, Second and Third positions in class (if more than 4 participants are duly registered).
